Official Formal Wear Outfit Rules Princess, Jr. Pre-Teen, & Pre-Teen:

- Select a formal dress that is appropriate for your age and personality.
- The dress may be any length and any style.
- No bare midriffs.
- Shoes should be small heels or flats that complement the dress. Make sure you can walk confidently, smoothly, and safely in your shoes.
- No noticeable makeup.

Jr. Teen, Teen, & Miss:

- Select a prom or formal dress that is appropriate for your age and personality.
- The dress may be any length and any style.
- Shoes should complement the dress. Make sure you can walk confidently, smoothly, and safely in your shoes.
- Makeup must be age-appropriate.

Scoring

Scoring is based on the judges' overall impression, and the finalist's ability to command attention with her poise and personality. Judges are looking for a representative who is wearing appropriate attire, and is confident and comfortable on stage.

Rehearsal

During Nationals, each National Finalist will attend a rehearsal so they may practice walking with their escort. Escorts are encouraged to attend this rehearsal, but it is not required. **Misses will not have an escort.**

Escorts

All age divisions except for Miss will need an escort for the Formal Wear Competition. Escorts may be a father, grandfather, brother, uncle, or any family member or friend.

Escorts are needed only during the Formal Wear Competition. You will be presented on stage unaccompanied during the Final Show. Thus, escorts will need a ticket if they plan to attend the Final Show.

Escorts may wear suits, tuxedos, their Sunday best, military uniforms, or something that complements your formal dress.

Walking Pattern Instructions

Stop 1

• All divisions except for Miss will briefly pause with escort. Then you will depart from your escort and walk toward Stop 2.


Stop 2

- Brief pose without turning your back to the audience. No spins or turns are allowed.
- Do not stop walking between Stop 2 and Stop 3.

Stop 3

• All age divisions except for Miss will meet escort, briefly pause, and then exit the stage together. Miss contestants will briefly pause and then exit the stage.
